Access to Recovery ... supports individuals experiencing long term mental health concerns to lead fulfilling, satisfying lives within their community. Individuals must be 16 years of age or older and living in Brampton, Caledon, or Malton.

Concurrent Disorders Crisis Management Services ... offers capacity-building opportunities for organizations that support individuals experiencing mental health and addiction concerns. Organizations must be based in Peel Region and/or the Central West LHIN (Local Health Integration Network).

FACT Peel+ ... supports individuals who have experienced a first episode of psychosis to lead fulfilling, satisfying lives within their community. Individuals must live in Peel Region and have had a first episode of psychosis within the past two years and be 16-45 years of age. (This is a partnership between CMHA/Peel, CAMH (Centre for Addiction and Mental Health), and (SHIP) Supportive Housing in Peel.

FACT Peel+ Malton ... provides support to individuals and their families at the first signs and symptoms of mental health issues. Individuals must be 16 – 35 years of age and live in Malton. *SHIP – Supportive Housing in Peel – provides a corresponding program for 16 – 35 year olds living in Dufferin County. Housing and Support Peel (HASP) ... offers permanent housing and support to individuals experiencing mental health concerns to lead fulfilling, satisfying lives in their community. Individuals must be 16 years of age and up, experience mental health concerns and be homeless or at risk of homelessness in Peel Region. Intake through Supportive Housing in Peel (SHIP): 905-795-8742.

McEvenue Home Works ... provides financial assistance to individuals living with mental health concerns who are experiencing a housing crisis and have exhausted all other financial options. Individuals, 16 and up, must live in the Region of Peel or within the boundaries of the Central West LHIN (Local Health Integration Network).

Mental Health & Justice Services ... offers a range of mental health supports to individuals experiencing mental health concerns, who are in conflict with the law. Toll free: 1-866-460-7335.

Resource Centre ... provides a welcoming point of entry to the mental health system by connecting individuals to information, education and services.

Treat at Home ... supports older adults experiencing mental health concerns to lead fulfilling, satisfying lives within their community. Treat at Home is a partnership with Reconnect Mental Health Services and CANES Community Care. CMHA/Peel serves anyone 65+ experiencing mental health concerns that interfere with their daily life in a significant way, or 55+ with both mental health concerns and complex physical health needs.
